

Somalia; Somali Parliament Speaker is in Punt-Land for Shadowed Reasons

Reports from Bosasso, the regional capitals of Somalia punt-land Region indicate that Somalia parliament Speaker and other self-autonomous Punt-land region descending members have reached there to receive recently published Somali currency.

Crowds of people and local self-autonomous punt-land authorities including president Ade Muse Hersi have welcomed the delegates led by the Speaker in Bossaso this afternoon.

Government sources detailed about the speakers' trip to Bossaso told Shabelle that it is for negotiating between Ade Muse, the president of Punt-Land and Somalia prime minister Ali Mohamed Gedi who recently sent a letter to Punt-Land state demanding natural Resource exploration in punt-Land territories should be stopped.

Punt-land reacted the demand angrily two weeks ago saying it has the right to explore Gas and other natural resources from it's territories.

Meanwhile, other sources in Baidoa told Shabelle radio through the phone that the speaker went for Punt-Land to receive 40 billions of Somali Shillings recently published in a foreign country.

The sources also confirmed that Somalia top Government authorities are planning to take Cash intended for the JNA project into their own accounts while falsehood published Somali currency will be used to implement the project.
